Update: Stolen iPads Located and Returned to School District

March 5, 2018 – Earlier today, an alert Tualatin Hills Parks & Recreation District employee located the stolen iPads in a garbage bag on a property in the area of Northwest Rock Creek Boulevard and Northwest Rock Creek Drive in Portland.

This afternoon, a Washington County Sheriff's Office school resource officer returned the iPads to the Beaverton School District. The district is reviewing the tablets to determine if any were damaged.

39 iPads and Two Projectors Stolen from Westview High School

February 5, 2018 – Three classroom portables were burglarized at Westview High School over the weekend, resulting in the theft of over \$15,000 in iPads and two projectors.

On the morning of February 5, 2018, Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies serving as school resource officers were notified by staff of a burglary that occurred sometime over the weekend at Westview High School.

Deputies learned that three classroom portables had been burglarized on Saturday between 11 p.m. and midnight. In total, 39 student iPads and two classroom projectors were stolen. At least one of the portables was forcibly entered through a locked window.

The iPads are generation 3 and valued at \$400 each. The Beaverton School District reports that the iPads have security
