## Woman Arrested After Menacing Trio with a Gun

August 27, 2018

On Sunday, August 26, 2018, at 11:05 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to the report of a menacing with a handgun at Vista Brook Park in Raleigh Hills. A group of three friends was walking in the park when they were approached by an individual who pointed a handgun at them. The trio ran to a nearby house and asked the homeowner to call 911. They were able to describe the suspect and the firearm.

Deputies converged on the area and walked the Fanno Creek Trail, which runs along the south side of the park. A short time later, deputies located and detained a person matching the suspect description. While searching the person, they located a realistic-looking Airsoft gun. The victims were able to positively identify the suspect.

Deputies arrested Kadin E. Moore, 19, of Beaverton and charged her with menacing. Ms. Moore explained that she was playing a prank on the group. The victims and the suspect did not know one another. Ms. Moore was lodged at the Washington County Jail and was released earlier this morning.

At this time, there is no known connection between this incident and a reported sexual assault that took place on the Fanno Creek Trail on July 19, 2018.
