Woman Arrested on Multiple Charges After DUII Crash

May 10, 2015 - Early this morning a woman was arrested after causing a two-vehicle crash. One person was injured in the crash. The suspect was charged with multiple charges including assault and resisting arrest.

On Sunday, May 10, 2015, at about 1:13 a.m., a Sheriff's Deputy witnessed a crash at the intersection of Kruse Way and the off-ramp from I-5 South. The victim's car, a 2004 Chevy four door, was leaving Hwy 217 South and proceeding through the intersection to Kruse Way when it was struck on the driver side by the suspect's 1999 Acura TL. The suspect was traveling south on the I-5 off-ramp.



The victim's car was occupied by three males; the driver Pedro Trujillo, 37, and passengers, Juan Trujillo, 24, and Elias Trujillo, 56, all from Portland. The suspect vehicle was driven by Hailey Elden, 21, from Tigard.

Deputies believe that Ms. Elden ran the red light and struck the other car. When deputies contacted her they quickly suspected that she was under the influence of something that was

impairing her ability to drive. She was arrested and they later determined that she had given them a false name. She was taken to an area hospital where she was treated and released. When the deputies attempted to take her to jail from the hospital she fought with them. No one was injured.



Hailey Elden

Elias Trujillo was extricated from the rear of the car by TVF&R personnel. He suffered non-life-threatening injuries and was treated and released from the hospital. No one else was injured in the crash.

Ms. Elden was charged with DUII, Reckless Driving, Assault IV, Possession of a Controlled Substance (Heroin), Resisting Arrest, False Information to Police, and a warrant for Failure to Appear in court on a previous heroin charge.
